#### **Proposed Transportation Policy**

Cape Romain Environmental Education Charter School utilizes transportation services through Coastal Bus Line. A bus fee will be added to the cost of the field trip. Occasionally, parent chaperone drivers may be asked to drive students on off-premise field trips. Parent drivers will assume the insurance requirements of transporting students. All drivers MUST provide the office with Proof of Insurance and the Number of seatbelts (lap or shoulder). It is imperative that <u>all</u> car safety regulations are observed while transporting other people's children.

#### **Use of Adult Volunteers and/or CREECS Employees to Transport Students**

An adult volunteer transporting students in a private or rental vehicle shall meet the following criteria:

- A. be at least twenty-one years old;
- B. provide the office with a copy of a valid driver's license;
- C. successfully pass a criminal background check;
- D. have liability coverage; and

E. have not had a conviction in the past ten years for an alcohol/drug related driving violation or more than two moving violations in the last twelve months.

Adult volunteer drivers of private or rental vehicles who provide transportation for students from school to approved school events, including field trips and extracurricular activities, must complete an Automobile Transportation Record for Student Activities form.

Parents must give prior informed consent for students to be transported by an adult volunteer

#### **Practices and Policies of Coastal Bus Line**

#### Drivers:

- Drug, alcohol screens at hire and random
- Criminal background checks
- 10 year driver record review at hire and annually
- DOT physical at hire and annually
- · Mandatory continuing education and training
- Pre- and post-trip after every pick up and drop off and when returning to yard to ensure no sleeping children are left behind

#### Vehicles:

- Meet or exceed DOT standards and safety requirements
- Undergo routine maintenance and daily inspection
- Equipped with:
- Seat belts
- Air conditioning
- GPS
- Security cameras on 90% of all vehicles
- Proximity to school allows for faster attention in the event an unexpected need arises

#### **Student Passenger In A Private or Rental Vehicle**

Cape Romain Environmental Education Charter School 1011 Old Cemetery Road McClellanville, SC 29458

With prior approval of the school principal, a private or rental vehicle may be used to transport a student to a school activity. The following requirements apply for authorized use of private or rental vehicles.:

- 1. Drivers may be a coach, teacher, parent, guardian, or other adult twenty-one years of age or older.
- 2. Drivers must have a valid South Carolina driver's license.
- 3. Drivers may not transport students if they have had a conviction in the past ten years for an alcohol/drug related driving violation or have had more than two moving violations in the last twelve months.
- 4. Drivers who are volunteers must have successfully completed a criminal background check if they will be transporting students.
- 5. Drivers must have liability insurance coverage for the vehicle.
- 6. The driver and all passengers must wear seat belts. It's the law.
- 7. The parent/guardian must give prior consent for his/her student to be transported by an adult driver in a private or rental vehicle to a school activity.
- 8. Drivers must confirm they will not be using a 15 passenger van or vehicle with more than 11 seats.
