At CREECS, our mission is to create a small and diverse collaborative learning community that immerses students in critical thinking, environmental stewardship, and engaged citizenship through meaningful and innovative learning experiences. CREECS engages family and community in the commitment to nurturing the whole child in preparation for a global society by emphasizing ecological conservation and sustainability.

A typical day at CREECS begins with students reporting to classrooms, listening to the morning announcements, and participating in a classwide morning meeting focusing on social-emotional learning. In addition to core classes, students participate in special area classes, including Environmental Education, Physical Education, and Art. Beginning this year, a team of trained Project-Based Learning teachers will collaborate across the curriculum to provide hands-on, project-based learning units for Kindergarten through Grade 8 students. Our unique campus offers students access to our playground, farm, and other green spaces daily, with plenty of time for play and exploration.

CREECS staff comprises highly qualified educators dedicated to ensuring growth and success for all students. Our newly created parent volunteer organization supports our students and teachers.
